

RECOMMENDED PACKING LIST FOR JOHNSTONE ADVENTURE LODGE

Temperatures and conditions in coastal Alaska are variable throughout the summer. If you come prepared for weather to be cool, warm, wet, dry, and windy—you have the best chance of enjoying your time in the great outdoors!

Pack items in a soft sided bag such as a duffle or backpack. The helicopter has a 550lb weight capacity and limited space so hard sided/wheeled luggage is not practical. If needed, storage can be provided for excess items and luggage.

- Rain gear—both rain pants and a rain jacket are highly recommended
- Rubber boots
- Long pants and long-sleeve shirts
- For base layers and general clothing: fleece, polyester, wool, and quick drying fabrics are preferable to cotton. Bring both thin and thicker tops.
- A jacket that would keep you comfortable in weather as low as 50°F/ 10°C
- Waterproof hiking boots
- Extra socks (wool is recommended)
- Light-weight gloves
- Beanie/cold weather hat
- Hat (full-rim preferred) and sunglasses
- Please be sure to pack all necessary prescriptions and personal items
